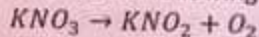

Since sets A and B have 2 and 3 elements respectively. So their Cartesian product $A \times B$ would have $6 (= 2 \times 3)$ elements.

We also know, *any subset of $A \times B$ is a relation from set A to set B* . But cardinal number of the set $A \times B$ is 6.

So maximum number of relations from set A to set B is = total number of subsets of the set $A \times B$

$$= 2^6$$

$$= 64. \quad \dagger$$
